<b>Adamic</b> (Unconditional)	Gen 3:14-19	Mankind	God modified His relationship due to sin	God put a curse upon the serpent God put a curse upon Satan God put a curse upon woman & man God put a curse upon the ground God put a curse upon humanity God gave the promise of a future Redeemer
