Midrash *B'Shelach* ("And He Sent") Exodus 13:17 – 17:16

Leaving Egypt Fully Armed

Exodus 13:17-22

Not through the way of the Philistines – they took the long path! Not the way that Moses had travelled 40 years earlier.

"Harnessed"- בְּלֵישִׁ בּים – "chamushim" – the number 5; or perhaps 50's (battle array)

In either case, it describes an orderly (military style) departure Could also mean that only 1 out of 5 Hebrews departed; the rest stayed in Egypt!

"pillar of cloud" – $\c v$ - anon; the same as on Mt Sinai

Exodus 19

Joel 2 & Zephaniah 1

& in the Day of the LORD

The Mouth of the Gorges

Exodus 14:1-14

Pe-ha-chirot - "Mouth of the Gorges" - probably the Wadi Watir

Migdol – "Tower" or "Fortress" – one of many security towers along Egypt's border

Baal-Zephon – "Lord of the North Land", suggestive of Judgment

Stone idol shaped like a fierce dog

When Israel stopped here, Pharaoh thought that the power of the

Egyptian gods had returned ... so he regained the courage to pursue Israel

God's Instructions:

1) Fear Not

Exodus 14:13

2) Stand Still (...maybe even "Get Out of My Way!")

3) See the Salvation of God

Red Sea is the boundary of Satan's authority – Joseph's bones out of Egypt

What is the Sea?

Revelation 17:15

Abram became the 1st *Ivrit* when he "crossed over" the Euphrates from Ur Israel became the Family of *Ivrit* when they "crossed over" the Red Sea

A Picture of Childbirth:

Squeezed in the "birth canal" of *Wadi Watir* Water breaking in the Red Sea crossing

"Out of Egypt I called My Son." Hosea 11:1

Crossing the Sea Exodus 14:15-31

Twπ choshech (darkness) – the same word as the 9th Plague

Darkness to Egyptians – Light for Israel!

Psalm 18:11

Egypt & Israel divided / Red Sea divided

The Egyptians' trouble crossing the Red Sea described in

Psalm 77:16-20

Egypt drowned Hebrew males in the Nile & Yehovah drowned their males in Red Sea

The Songs of Moses & Miriam

Exodus 15:1-21

This is the 1st song in Scripture

1st time "salvation" appears.... and only <u>after</u> the blood is applied!

Verse 13 – the summary verse for Exodus ... and also Revelation

The 2nd Song of Moses

Bitter Waters Made Sweet

Revelation 15:1-4 **Exodus 15:22-27**

"They could not drink the waters...for they were bitter."

מָרָים marim – same consonants as Miriam

Miriam <u>praised</u> because of their deliverance from the salt (bitter) water The people complained because they had only salt water to drink

Mayim Chayim The Living Water Etz Chayim The Tree of Life

John 7:37-39 Revelation 22:1-3

Tree of Life + His Statutes = "None of these diseases"!
No Statutes until Deliverance!

12 wells & 70 palm trees

Luke 9:1 & 10:1

Manna from Heaven

Exodus 16:1-36

Better described in Numbers 11: As coriander seed Small & round Color of bdellium (white) If left overnight:

Tasted like fresh oil breeds worms & stinks and honey except on Shabbat

Fell only upon Israel – not any of the others around them! Another Precision Event! First, the dew, then manna, then more dew

Ate it for 40 years! ... a test of Israel

Deuteronomy 8:2-3

Gave them what they <u>wanted</u> ... teaching them it's not what they <u>needed</u>
Gave them physical bread...teaching them they need spiritual bread (The Word)

Water from the Rock Exodus 17:1-7

The same rod that made the Nile undrinkable brought forth water from a rock!

Meribah - ที่ว่าวู้ Strife or Contention

Rephidim – ロブラコ "Resting Place"

"Upon this Rock ... " Matthew 16:18

Who is The Rock?

Nebuchadnezzar's Statue

I Corinth 10:1-5

Daniel 2

"Stone Which the Builders Rejected" Psalm 118:22

The Rock was smitten (struck) one time

Compare to Moses' mistake

Isaiah 53:4

Numbers 20

Defeat of *Amalek* (the 1st Battle)

lek (the 1st Battle) **Exodus 17:8-16**

Who is *Amalek*? (War-like)

See Balaam's Account

Genesis 36:11-12 & Deut 25:17-19

Numbers 24:20

Amalek Did not fear God

1st to attack Israel – from the rear, upon the "faint & weary" Deuteronomy 25:18

Successfully put down (at least temporarily)

Destiny is to be ultimately destroyed (Balaam's Prophecy in Numbers 24:20)

Lesson for Today: Never doubt that God is with us!

Symbolic of the War Between Flesh & Spirit

Victory as long as Moses' hands were held up by Aaron & Hur

"steady" מוֹנוֹ emunah - truth

Aaron = Priesthood

Hur (Light) suggests Ruach HaKodesh (Holy Spirit)
